Cam Tu Vo Nguyen is a dual-qualified lawyer admitted in Paris and New York, with a pending admission to the roll of solicitors of England & Wales. She currently works at The Arbitration Chambers (TAC) in Singapore where she acts as tribunal secretary appointed in a wide range of arbitration cases governed by major institutional arbitration rules such as AIAC, DIFC-LCIA, HKIAC, ICC, LCIA, SIAC, SCMA and in ad-hoc arbitration cases governed by UNCITRAL arbitration rules.

Prior to joining TAC, Cam Tu practiced international arbitration as counsel with the Singapore office of a leading Vietnamese law firm. She has worked with the ICC International Court of Arbitration in Paris, as well as with leading international arbitration law firms in Paris and Ho Chi Minh City.

Neil Kaplan, CBE KC SBS (Arbitration Chambers, Hong Kong)

Neil Kaplan CBE KC SBS has been a full-time practising arbitrator since 1995. During this period, he has been involved in several hundred arbitrations as co-arbitrator, sole arbitrator or chairman. These arbitrations have included a wide range of commercial, infrastructural and investment treaty disputes under the rules of the ICC, HKIAC, LCIA, UNCITRAL, SIAC, SCC, ICSID and CIETAC. Neil has also presided over ad hoc arbitrations as well as bilateral investment treaty cases administered by the PCA.

He is a Chartered Arbitrator and a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, the Hong Kong Institute of Arbitrators. Additionally, he is a panelist of several other arbitral institutions including CIETAC. Since 2017, Neil has been the president of the Court of the Mauritius Chamber of Commerce and Industry Arbitration and Mediation Centre. In 2020, he was appointed first president of Delos Dispute Resolution's board of advisers. In 2022, Neil was appointed as a Deputy President of the Bahrain Court of Cassation.



Chiann Bao, FCI Arb (Arbitration Chambers, Singapore)

Chiann Bao is an independent arbitrator with Arbitration Chambers. She has been appointed as chair, co-arbitrator, and emergency arbitrator in arbitrations under most of the major institutional rules with several billion USD in dispute. She currently serves as a Senior Vice Chair of the IBA Arbitration Committee. She is also a Vice President of the ICC Court of Arbitration and a co-chair of the ICC Commission's Task Force on ADR and Arbitration.

From 2010 to 2018, she served as the Secretary General of the HKIAC and was subsequently appointed as a Council Member of the HKIAC. Chiann is a member of the Board of Trustees and an honorary senior fellow of the British Institute of International and Comparative Law. She is a Chartered Arbitrator and CEDR-accredited mediator.
