Whilst this minefield engenders challenges for international arbitration, the unique features of arbitration may offer vistas for international commerce to better adapt to the new reality. This conference will investigate the complex challenges posed by sanctions, and identify and assess their impact on the various actors in international arbitration – arbitration institutions, arbitrators, and the parties – across the stages of agreeing to arbitrate, the arbitration proceeding, and the enforcement of arbitral awards.
