AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION DECLARATION

Individuals will be automatically disqualified from acting as a Trustee of a charity if:

- one or more of the reasons set out in the Charity Commission's 'disqualifying reasons table'
 (found here²) apply; and
- they have not obtained a waiver of that disqualification from the Charity Commission.

Completing the declaration

Read the automatic disqualification <u>guidance</u>³ to decide if you are disqualified from acting as a charity Trustee.

Complete and sign this declaration to confirm that you are not disqualified.

If one of the disqualification reasons does apply, you may be able to apply for a waiver from the Charity Commission⁴ which will allow you to take up or continue to act as a Trustee.
