What are the learning outcomes?

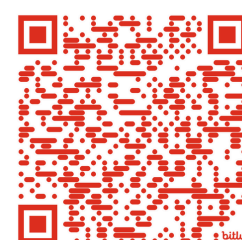
On successful completion of this course candidates will be able to:
